

## BIBLICAL ORGANIZATIONAL KEYS

Ex 39:42-43

42 According to all that the Lord had commanded Moses, so the children of Israel did all the work.

43 Then Moses looked over all the work, and indeed they had done it; as the Lord had commanded, just so they had done it. And Moses blessed them. NKJV

### INSTRUCTION vs 42

A. “**According** to all that The Lord had commanded Moses,”

1. Moses received the Vision

B. “So the children of Israel did all the work”

1. Moses instructed the children of Israel on what to build...according to what The Lord showed him

- a. Israel could not build the tabernacle any way they personally choose
- b. It had to be built according to the vision / pattern God gave Moses

### INSPECTION vs 43

A. “Then Moses **looked over** all the work”

1. Do not **EXPECT** what you do not **INSPECT**

2. You must learn the difference from: “**DUMPING**” compared to “**DELEGATING**”

a. **Dumping**: you do not inspect what you have delegated

b. This leads to:

(1) no accountability

(2) people building what they want and not what God showed you

(3) or: people being unfaithful with their responsibilities

(a) It is fine for people to use their gifts, talents and methods.....but it all must lead to what you instructed them to build / do

(b) **Delegating**: Moses “looked over” or inspected the work of Israel making sure that what they were building was according to what God spoke to him

### IMPARTATION OF BLESSING vs 43

A. “indeed they have done it; as The Lord had commanded, just so they done it. And Moses **blessed them**”

1. Moses did not release his blessing / approval upon the tabernacle that the children of Israel built until:

- a. They first received Moses Instruction
- b. It passed Moses Inspection
- c. The Moses Blessed them
