NOVEMBER 2011 MISSIONS UPDATE: NIGERIA & UGANDA TRIP

NIGERIA, WEST AFRICA

In November Dr. Pangio arrived in Lagos, Nigeria. From Nov. 3, 4, 5, & 7 Dr. Pangio ministered in revival meetings with our new Abundant Ministries director in Nigeria: Rev. Samuel Mohie. These revival services were held Wednesday thru Friday & Sunday at The Touch of God Bible Church of which Rev. Samuel Mohie serves as the apostle of this net work of churches. Rev. Mohie is assisted by his wife Margaret and son Ebenezer in the oversight of his churches. The people were hungry for the Word of God, and souls were saved in every one of the services. The Holy Spirit's presence was very strong as healing and deliverance took place in the lives of those who came to the altar for ministry.

Construction Project: Rev. Sam is currently in the midst of a building program for his church in Lagos. The downstairs of the project has been completed (which the church & bible school currently occupies. They are now in the midst of believing God for completion of the second floor of the church building. Abundant Ministries is also believing God to assist them financially by helping them erect the walls of the second floor. The total cost of finishing the entire second floor is: \$9, 400.00 USA funds. MORE ABUNDANT WORD BIBLE SCHOOL NEWS:

Rev. Samuel Mohie will also be opening a second Abundant Word Bible School in Abuja, the capitol city of Nigeria. The school will officially open the second week of December, and will be located in Rev. Mohie's church.

Also, Rev. David Isah Ifoto from Ughelli, Delta State Nigeria will be opening a third Abundant Word Bible School in the month of December. Rev. Ifoto travelled by road for nine hours to connect with Dr. Pangio in Lagos. Rev. Ifoto and Dr. Pangio have been in contact with each other for almost a year and a half making plans for opening a bible school in his area. The Delta State which Rev. Ifoto is located in is an extremely hot spot for radical Muslims and terrorist activity. Rev. Mohie advised against Dr. Pangio travelling into the area at this time, but plans are being made for Dr. Pangio, Rev. Mohie to travel to the Delta State in November 2012. Rev. Mohie is looking at the various means by which we can travel by road to the Delta State with the proper Security in place next November.

SECOND LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE HELD IN LAGOS, NIGERIA.

On Monday & Tuesday (Nov. 7 & 8) Dr. Pangio spoke at the annual conference of the Restoration Hour Jesus Ministry in Satellite Town, (just outside of Lagos), Rev. Emma Igwe is the Senior Pastor. Dr. Pangio was one of the key note speakers in the nightly revival meetings. On Monday night Dr. Pangio preached on "Imparting Into the Next Generation, and on Tuesday he preached on the "Seven Ways Jesus Shed His Blood, for Your Healing". After which a healing line was set up and many received healing and deliverance as hands were laid upon them. The greatest miracle of all manifested in each of the revival services as souls repented of their sins, and accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and savior.

On Monday morning and afternoon, Dr. Pangio held a Leadership Conference and taught on "Biblical Principles for Raising up Spiritual Sons".

UGANDA EAST AFRICA

On November 10 Dr. Pangio travelled to Entebbe, Uganda to connect with Rev. John Kamulegeya who is the Apostle and Overseer of The Pentecostal Church Ministries, and now serves as the Director of our Abundant Word Bible College in Mityana, Uganda. After landing in the capitol city of Entebbe at 3 a.m. Dr. Pangio and Rev John drove three hours to Mityana where they began ministry that afternoon. Mityana became our base of operation from which we would work from for the next nine days as we travelled two and three hours one way to various villages conducting Leadership Conferences.

Our first meeting was held in the village of Kaloga, as we arrived the children choir was out in front of the church singing a “welcome song” to us. We were then ushered in the church building that was filled with hungry souls. Adult and children choirs ministered in song, and the Praise & Worship Team sang and danced in the presence of The Lord. The music was simply the beat kept on an African drum, as the people sang unto Our Lord Jesus Christ. Dr. Pangio preached on “Going All The Way with God”, and lives were touched by The Holy Spirit as decisions were made to follow Jesus Christ, and others rededicated their life to a deeper commitment in serving God. The next day we travelled to Nalugazi Village and held a Leadership Conference. The building was made up of tree limbs that served as posts, dirt floors, a tin roof, and side boards nailed on to the tree limbs of the four walls. The fourth wall was left open as tarps were strong up between trees to provide shade for the over flow crowd, and at least another seventy five people sat under the trees outside the facility to hear the Word of God. There were over three hundred Pastors and church leaders in attendance as Dr. Pangio taught The Word of God. The people were not use to the Word of God being ministered in a way where bible passages relating to the subject were turned to and read, mainly because many in attendance (including pastors) could not read or write. Dr. Pangio taught on: Biblical Church Government, Balance in ministry, The Order of Spiritual Sons, and the Five Attributes of faith”. Pastors were strengthened and church leaders were blessed as the Word of God touched their heart. In the last session Dr. Pangio took time to lay hands on the sick and possessed and the Lord set captives free. Pictures below are from the Leadership Conference in Nalugazi Village



On Sunday Dr. Mike ministered in Rev. John's new church plant in Mityana. The praise team and choir ministered in music, it was so obvious to see how much the people in Uganda love to spend their time singing praises unto The Lord. Dr. Mike preached a message entitled "The Three Appearances of Jesus", this message Challenged both saint and sinner in regards to their relationship with Jesus Christ. Souls were touched as they responded to the altar call.

BIBLE SCHOOL IN MITYANA

We planted an Abundant Ministries Bible School in Mityana. This is the only town that had a paved road going thru the midst of it, so it is a little easier for the Pastors and Bible School students to travel to the bible school. The road conditions in Uganda as bad if not worse as anything I have seen in Africa. There would be one paved road that serves as the main artery to a region of the country, and even that road will have miles of disrepair. Dirt roads branch off from the paved road leading to villages throughout the country. These roads are not maintained at all, "pot holes" cannot even described the terrible condition these roads are in. We constantly drove through nothing but mud and standing water and had to get out of the vehicle to either push or get the weight out of the car so it could drive thru a small pond (which was actually the road). The majority of the people who live in these areas have no running water, nor electricity, and have to walk for miles to get to the paved road in order to get a taxi (for a lack of better words) to take them to their destination.

Another factor in determining to plant the bible school in Mityana is the fact that it had electricity in the building. Even with electricity ran to the building we still are going to purchase a generator for the Bible School due to the fact that the entire region (not just the town) can go days without electricity. When I was staying there the power would go off and on every day, and at one point we were four days straight without any electricity. We plan on purchasing the generator this December, if you would like to contribute to the purchase of the generator or if you would desire to simply by it and have it dedicated to the Bible School in your name the cost to purchase the generator is \$250.00 (two hundred fifty dollars). We held our Third Leadership Conference in Demba Village. Pastor John informed me that many of the Pastors got up at the crack of dawn and walked for hours to make the eight mile walk to the conference. The people gathered outside on the church property hiding from the sun under tarps that were tied off of the buildings and on to the trees. The people were so grateful that we had put forth such an effort to come to their village. Due to the road conditions it was a three hour journey from Mityana to Demba Village. We always tried to end the conferences by 4:p.m. so we could get back to the paved road before dark, needless to say our plan did not always work out.

Dr. Mike taught the word of God and ministered to the leaders on the following topics: “The Example of Spiritual Fathers, Biblical Church Government, and the “Seven Ways Jesus Shed His Blood to Bring You Healing”. After the Ministry of the Word of God, Dr. Mike and Pastor John laid hands on all of the leaders, and prayed for the sick. There was a very strong presence of The Lord as we ministered in this remote villages.

Our fourth Leadership Conference was held in Lumbali Village. The church was located on the main road of the village (though a dirt road) the entire village was aware of the conference due to our location, and the PA System blasting the sound of the praise & worship and ministry of The Word of God. Eight Pastors brought their church leaders and congregations together for this meeting. Even though poverty was all around us and the living conditions very difficult, the atmosphere in this meeting was charged with expectancy. Dr. Mike taught on: “Joshua an Example of Leadership Qualifications, Biblical Church Government, and The Seven Fold Blessing of Sowing Your Seed”. The Lord spoke to my heart and told me “in order for the curse of poverty to be broken, they must sow their seed in order to have a harvest in their future”. After teaching Pastors, church leaders, and congregation these spiritual principles I encouraged the people to give / sow a financial seed (the amount was between them and God)...so God could bless it and bring a harvest into their future. As the people came forth to give we rebuked curses and the spirit of poverty in their lives and over their village. As in all of our Leadership Conferences the offerings remain in the church that hosts the conference.

It is thru the seed you sow that we are able to hold these Leadership Conferences, feed everyone in attendance, purchase the 60 hour DVD Bible School materials (in their own native language), DVD players, TV’s, and generators. As well as providing an accredited Associate In Theology Degree for the amount of \$50.

Once again I want to thank you for your prayers and financial seed that enable me to take the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the World, conduct Leadership Conferences, plant Bible Schools, and plant new churches with the graduates of the Bible Schools.

JANUARY 2012

In January 2012 I will be sending one of our West Africa Directors to the nation of Senegal, West Africa. According to the latest missions reports on religion in Senegal, it is 90% Muslim with only 125 (one hundred twenty five) Christian Pastors in the nation. Our Abundant Ministries Director Rev. Axe Freeman is close friends with one of the pastors in Senegal. He has contacted him by phone and the Pastor in Senegal has agreed to host our Leadership Conference in August 2012, and hold our Abundant Word Bible School in his local church. To send Rev. Freeman for one week (travel, food, border fees, etc.) to lay the ground work for this project will cost a Minimum of \$1,500.00 (fifteen hundred USA dollars. If The Lord speaks to your heart to help us in this project, one hundred percent of what you give will be designated to our Senegal Project”
